Frequently Asked Questions about NCE Summer Residential Programming

ACCOMMODATION

- The players are in twin rooms and pairs of twin rooms share a shower and toilet.
- We will endeavor to post the rooming list on the camp info page prior to check-in. .
- The rooms do not have fridges but there is a fridge on site for medicines.
- Bedding is not provided by the university and all players will need their own bedding, pillows, and towels.
- All dorms are air conditioned.

PACKING LIST

- All information on what to bring can be found on the program web pages.
- In addition to the full camp kit all NCE players will need their complete NCE black COE training kit and the white COE training jersey.

MEDICAL NEEDS

- There will be a trainer at camp for the player's medical needs.
- Camp medical staff will store and administer medication if necessary.
- Please make NCE Staff aware of any medical issues prior to camp.
- All players are required to provide a completed NCE medical authorization form to participate on camp.

FOOD AND DIETARY NEEDS

- ALL dietary needs are catered for by the university. For those campers with severe allergies, we will ask you to make us aware of this before the event so we can then pass along the information to DeSales University.
- Non-perishable snacks & drinks can be kept in the player's rooms.
- 3 meals a day are provided but we also have pizza in the evening which players can purchase by the slice.

MISCELLANEOUS

- A small amount of spending money for the week (\$20-40) is recommended to buy pizza in the evening or DeSales branded gear which is available.
- There are FREE laundry facilities on site, but players will need washing powder/liquid/pods and dryer sheets.
- Players are not allowed to leave campus during the residential camp.
- There is FREE Wi-Fi at the University and in the dorm rooms.

PARENTS AND SUPPORTERS' INVOLVEMENT

- Parents and supporters are allowed to watch the games in the evening at camp.
- We do not encourage parents to be at camp at any other times.
- Parents and supporters are not allowed into dorms after check in. In the case of an issue that requires urgent attention please contact an NCE member of staff.

CAMP STAFFING

- The camp staff is made up of NCE Coaching Staff, International Academy Coaches and camp chaperones.
- Goalkeepers will have their own coach and work together then join in with the other players for the evening games.
- The expected coach to player ratio is approximately 1:15 for U9 to U12 and 1:18 for U13 to U18.
- Coaching Staff will be supplemented by camp counselors to manage transfer from dorms to fields and also lights out and player welfare.
- Counselors are NCE Alumni and players from the Men's and Women's soccer teams at DeSales University
