SCOTT MIDDLEMASS – NORTH ATLANTIC REGIONAL DIRECTOR

Scott was raised in England in a soccer family and followed his father into the professional game. Scott's professional career lasted over 14 years, taking him to 4 countries (England, China, Norway, and the U.S.) and 3 continents.

Scott arrived in South Jersey in 2001 after he retired from playing and became the Technical Director for a local South Jersey Club where he worked for 13 years.

He went on to build a club-neutral Talent ID structure for a league with teams and players from DE, PA, and South Jersey, and, at its height, this program had four separate training centers in which there were local, district, and regional level training groups.

Many of the players that attended the training centers had the opportunity to travel to Brazil, Argentina, Belgium, Portugal, Spain and/or England to compete against teams such as Manchester City, Vasco de Gama, Argentina Juniors, Celtic, Borussia Dortmund, Liverpool, Chelsea and Barcelona.

Scott currently resides in South Jersey and is responsible for delivering NCE programming within NJ, DE and PA.



LEE BROSTER – SENIOR GOALKEEPER COACH

He was formerly goalkeeping and lead foundation coach at Notts County, the oldest professional football club in the world, responsible for implementing the goalkeeping syllabus for youth players aged 9-to-18-years. Lee delivered comprehensive coaching for goalkeepers in the Senior First and Reserve teams as well as the supervision of coaching staff, ensuring safeguarding policies were followed across the Academy. This included organized assessment evenings to advise and discuss young player development with parents and guardians. He worked alongside first team manager Martin Allen and three of his young graduates went on to win professional contracts with Notts County before moving to the US in 2015 to coach with PDP before joining forces with John Curtis and the NCE Soccer team.

Lee has grown the goalkeeping Centre of Excellence program from a handful of young keepers to a roster full of talent coaching more than 400 youngsters in the past three years. Lee is well qualified and has successfully achieved UEFA B License Level 3 in both Outfield and Goalkeeping, UEFA level 2, and Youth Module 1 & 2 qualifications.

Monday April 3rd - Hotel Poiano on Lake Garda

PM - Arrival at Milan international airport Terminal 1 and meet our bilingual tour directors then board our 2 private buses for the week. First stop is Lake Garda area for free time and visit some of the lakeside towns such as Sirmione or Peschiera del Garda.

PPM - At the end of the day transfer to our hotel in Verona/Lake Garda area for check in and dinner.

Tuesday April 4th - Hotel Poiano on Lake Garda

AM - After breakfast players have an early transfer to Chievo Verona Serie A Youth headquarter for a training session with their qualified coaches.

PM - After training we depart to visit Venice with free time to stop for lunch on the way. After arrival at the bus parking area, we will transfer to the city center by private boat. Once there, free time to enjoy the beautiful city with its many canals and bridges.

PPM - Midafternoon we will return to our hotel for dinner.

Sunday April 9th - Una Hotel Expo Fiera Milano


AM - After breakfast head to the tournament where we hope to compete in the Finals!



- 3. Independent Travelers i.e., not registered for Fan Tour
 - a) We can not provide tickets for events or transportation for those supporters who are not part of the NCE Supporters tour.
 - b) We will inform you of locations for training and games so you can make you own way to the location.
- 4. Make sure you have completed the Information capture Link

6. Completing Forms

- a) Make sure you complete the COVID form and send this to <u>nick@ncesoccer.com</u> as instructed. This form can be found on the tour page. Without a completed form US Soccer will not approve your travel.
- b) ALL players traveling without parents need to provide the NCE Staff with a signed Medical Form and Travel Consent Form which can also be found on the tour page and e mailed to <u>nick@ncesoccer.com</u>

7. Do I need health insurance?

a) We recommend you consider health insurance for your travel with options available via our tour webpage.

8. What do I do if I have not received my NCE International Uniform?

- a) All players should now have ordered and received their international uniform with number or have a delivery date.

9. Cell Phones

a) Check your cell phone provider for international rates. If you do not have an international plan then switch your phone to airline mode for the time you are overseas.

10. Packing List

- a) Players to travel in full tracksuit and polo shirt for the flight.
- b) We will try to do a laundry during the week but suggest a small bottle of detergent in your checked bag.

Some further Important Points

1. Money

- a) Spending money for players is recommended for additional meals (up to \$20 per meal) shopping, snacks, evening activities, etc.
- b) We suggest having money to tip our driver and guides, about a US dollar a day per person in your party is a fair amount.
- c) All major credit cards are accepted but we suggest getting some EURO's before you travel for incidentals when you arrive.
- d) Tell your bank about your upcoming travel so purchases are not declined, and you can use the ATM.

2. Communications

3. Trip Preparation

- a) An adaptor is required in order to use electronic equipment, such as hairdryers, iPods, alarm clocks, razors, computers, etc.
- b) Consider jet lag preventative measures. It is encouraged that each passenger gets up and walks around during the flight to prevent blood clots. Sleeping on the plane will help, and make sure you have your water bottle with you.
- c) Pack prescription medications in your carry-on just in case you have trouble locating your baggage upon arrival.
- d) Good idea to have your playing kit in your carry on just in case!
- e) Check the weather prior to your trip so you are aware of what additional items may be needed.
- f) Be sure to have luggage tags on which your name, home address, and phone number are written clearly.

4. COVID INFORMATION

- a) USEFUL SITE COVID 19 Info for travelers to Italy
- b) Are there COVID-related entry requirements for U.S. citizens? No. U.S. citizens may travel to Italy for any reason, including tourism. English-language guidance on current entry and exit requirements is maintained on the <u>Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs' website</u>. Further information is also available on the <u>Italian Ministry of Health's website</u>.
- c) Is a negative COVID-19 test (PCR and/or serology) required for entry? No
- d) Are health screening procedures in place at airports and other ports of entry? Yes, from December 29, 2022 to January 31, 2023, all travelers arriving or transiting in Italy from China must:
 - a) Have a negative COVID test prior to their departure (a molecular test within 72 hours prior to arriving in Italy or an antigen test within 48 hours prior to arriving in Italy)
 - b) Undergo an additional COVID test administered by Italian airport authorities upon arriving in Italy. This requirement does not apply to children under the age of 6, crew members, or diplomats.
