Once through customs and immigration, we will meet up and connect with our bus driver and follow itinerary.

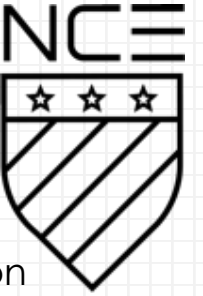


Itinerary and check in

Day 1 - Saturday

- Depart New York airport and travel to London, England

Day 2 - Sunday

- Meet up with group after passing through immigrations and customs at London Heathrow with times and location to be confirmed.
- Travel north to Oakham School with stop for lunch at services.
- Arrive at Oakham and check into accommodations.
- Afternoon training session with NCE Coaching Staff.
- Dinner then team meeting and lights out.

Day 3 - Monday

- Pro Training Day with coaches from a top English Academy.
- Morning session then lunch
- Afternoon session then dinner
- Evening team meeting then lights out.

Day 4 - Tuesday

- Morning training session with NCE Staff coach to prepare for Festival and Tournament.
- Afternoon games festival with warm up friendly games against local top Academy teams such as Birmingham City, Northampton Town and Burton Albion.
- All games at Oakham School.



Day 5 - Wednesday

Day 1 of Tournament

- Up to Three games on day one
- All tournament games will be played at Oakham School
- Age groups with less than 7 teams will also have a penalty shoot out competition between teams that counts towards final standings.

Day 6 - Thursday

Day 2 of Tournament

- Up to Four games on day two,
- At the end of day two the teams split into two even groups.

Day 7 – Friday

Day 3 of Tournament

- Each group plays semi-finals and finals on day three,
- After lunch players, staff and chaperones will then head to Rutland Water Park for 2 hours of play and adventure! Slip, slide, splash and share laugh-out-loud moments on their giant inflatable obstacle courses.

SOME IMPORTANT POINTS

1. Rooming and Accommodation

- a) All players will stay at Oakham School in bedrooms that will sleep 2 to 3 people.
- b) We will make our best efforts to accommodate rooming requests
- c) **ALL PLAYERS AND ADULTS STAYING AT OAKHAM SCHOOL WILL NEED TO BRING THEIR OWN TOWEL AND TOILETRIES. BEDDING IS PROVIDED.**
- d) All meals will be at Oakham School for players who have been informed of any dietary needs.

2. Uniform and Laundry

- a) Remember to put your name in all your kit.
- b) All players on the group flight will TRAVEL IN NCE TRACKSUIT AND POLO.
- c) We suggest packing your NCE training kit and uniform in your carry on so its available for our initial training session on arrival.
- d) The dorms where we are staying will have laundry facilities that chaperones and staff can assist with.

3. Do I need health insurance?

- a) We recommend you consider health insurance for your travel and options can be found on our web page or at <https://gamer.tripmate.com/?welcome=SELE0324SC>
- b) Check with your current provider and even your credit card company as they may offer insurance.

4. Frequently Asked Questions

- a) Have some English money for incidentals such as lunch on way to Oakham, when we go to live games to buy food and souvenirs.
- b) Souvenir T-shirts will be on sale at the fields with cash & card taken at Oakham
- c) There will be food and drink available at the tournament and staff and chaperones can take players into the town center to purchase additional items.
- d) Tell your bank about your upcoming travel so purchases are not declined, and you can use the ATM. Also make sure you have your pin number for using any credit cards overseas just in case you need to authorize payment.
- e) Contact your cell phone provider to check if they offer international plans.
- f) Make sure you bring an empty water bottle that you can fill at the airport to stay hydrated. You will also need this for the games.
- g) Only NCE staff and approved chaperones will be allowed to enter the school dormitories.
- h) If the schedule allows then parents and supporters may be able to take their player from the school, but this will need to be authorized by a lead NCE Staff coach.

MORE IMPORTANT POINTS

- c) Check out the tournament app that has updated fixtures and results that you can connect with using your smart phone.
- d) There will also be a professional photographer at the tournament talking photos of players and games that are available to purchase.
- e) We will set up a WhatsApp group to provide notification on tour and share details.
- f) For players travelling alone we need guardians to sign travel consent. Players need original form for flight from and to USA. No need for COVID Waiver form anymore.
- g) All players must provide a medical consent form

2. What live games will we be watching?

- a) At time of presentation, we have the following live matches confirmed
 - a) 2008 Boys – Saturday July 29th Derby County vs Sheffield United (Pre-Season Friendly)
 - b) 2009 and 2011 Boys – Saturday August 5th Derby County vs Wigan Athletic (English League 1)
 - c) 2010 and 2012 Boys – Saturday August 12th Coventry City vs Middlesbrough (English Championship)
 - d) 2011 Girls - TBD

3. Can supporters who are not part of the group get tickets and travel to the live games?

- a) At present tickets and transport are only for those part of the players or supporter's package.
- b) If tickets and space on the bus is available, we will inform those independent travelers who have expressed an interest in tickets.

4. Can supporters who are part of the group or independently traveling watch the NCE games.

- a) We actively encourage as many supporters as possible to come along to the games
- b) There is no parking space at the fields so if you are driving to the fields, then you will need to park at the main school and mini-busses will then transfer you.

5. Our Expectations

- a) Players should understand they are representing themselves, their family, NCE Soccer and the USA and we expect them to act in a way that reflects the behavior expected at a professional academy. NCE Soccer will take the necessary steps to address any issues or concerns which could include removal from the tour.
