

Frequently Asked Questions about NCE Summer Residential Programming



ACCOMMODATION

- The players are in twin rooms and pairs of twin rooms share a shower and toilet.
- Players will find out roommates at camp check-in.
- The rooms do not have fridges but there is a fridge on site for medicines.
- Bedding is not provided by the university and all players will need their own bedding, pillows, and towels.
- All dorms are air conditioned.

PACKING LIST

- All information on what to bring can be found on the program web pages.
- Players will receive a voucher which is included in the camp fee to purchase the required camp kit from the soccer.com website.
- In addition to the full camp kit all NCE players will need their complete NCE black COE training kit and the white COE training shirt.

MEDICAL NEEDS

- There will be a trainer at camp for player's medical needs.
- Camp medical staff will store and administer medication if necessary.
- Please make NCE Staff aware of any medical issues prior to camp.
- All players are required to provide a completed NCE medical authorization form to participate on camp.

FOOD AND DIETARY NEEDS

- ALL dietary needs are catered for by the university. For those campers with severe allergies, we will ask you to make us aware of this before the event so we can then pass along the information to DeSales University.
- Non-perishable snacks & drinks can be kept in player's rooms.
- 3 meals a day are provided but we also have pizza in the evening which players can purchase by the slice.

MISCELLANEOUS

- A small amount of spending money for the week (\$20-40) is recommended to buy pizza in the evening or DeSales branded gear which is available.
- There are FREE laundry facilities on site, but players will need washing powder/liquid/pods and dryer sheets.
- Players are not allowed to leave campus during the residential camp.
- There is FREE Wi-Fi at the University and in the dorm rooms.

PARENTS AND SUPPORTERS' INVOLVEMENT

- Parents and supporters are allowed to watch the games in the evening at camp.
- Parents and supporters are not allowed into dorms after check in. In the case of an issue that requires urgent attention please contact an NCE member of staff.



CAMP STAFFING

- The camp staff is made up of NCE Coaching Staff for residential camp and college coaches for College ID camp. For the Pro Pathway Camp the coaching staff will be made up of International Academy Coaches.
- Goalkeepers will have their own coach and work together then join in with the other players for the evening games.
- The expected coach to player ratio is approximately 1:15 for U9 to U12 and 1:18 for U13 to U18.
- Coaching Staff will be supplemented by camp counsellors to manage transfer from dorms to fields and also lights out and player welfare.

COLLEGE ID CAMP

- Parents and supporters are not allowed to attend the seminars or workshops at the College ID Camp but we intend to have recruitment seminars and workshops during our Showcase Tournaments.
