

Residential camp NCE player behavioral document

This Document must be signed by both the parent and player and handed in during the camp checkin process.

Failure to abide by the rules after both parent and player has signed this document can result in the following consequences.

- Player unable to take part in a certain training time slot.
- Player unable train for next day after infraction.
- Parents called to come and collect player/players concerned from the camp.

Players are expected to behave in a courteous and professional manner whilst taking part in the residential camp both in the living areas, Cafeteria, traveling to and from the field as well as on the field.

Living area:

- Players expected to keep their room clean and tidy.
- No soccer balls within the living area
- No running, screaming or play fighting in hallways or rooms.
- No entering or leaving through fire exits.
- Players must sleep in the room that is assigned to them.
- No player must be in hallways or in another room after designated curfew.
- No players must leave the living area at night whilst on camp.

Cafeteria:

- No running or screaming in the cafeteria area.
- Players must show respect and listen to college cafeteria staff on what they can and cannot eat as part of the camp menu.
- Players are expected to clean their plates and tables and not leave until they have been dismissed back to the living areas.
- No cleats, slides, or crocks to be worn to and from the cafeteria.

Not tolerated on Camp:

- Bullying of any type.
- Racism.
- Stealing of others property
- Swearing.
- Disrespectful behavior to either NCE staff or Camp staff.
- Disruptive and destructive behavior anywhere on Campus.
