



1. What is the NCE Soccer College Pathway Program?

The NCE Soccer College Pathway Program is an 8-month long recruitment initiative designed to help student-athletes navigate the college recruitment process. It includes events, showcases, webinars, and personal consultations with college recruitment experts.

2. What does the program include?

The program consists of:

- 4 Webinars
- 4 Winter Showcases
- 1 Summer Showcase
- 1 College Combine
- 1 College Pathway Residential Camp
- A Player Profile Page
- A Highlight Reel
- Personal College Consultancy

3. Who is eligible to join the program?

This program is offered to select U16-U18 boys and girls who have been identified by NCE as having the potential to play at the collegiate level, based on their performance at previous NCE events.

4. What is the cost of the program?

The total cost is \$2,699, paid in installments:

- \$699 deposit upon registration
- \$500 on January 1st
- \$500 on February 1st
- \$500 on June 1st
- \$500 final payment on July 1st

This cost covers all events and services within the program but does not include travel expenses.

5. Where will the events take place?

Events will be held at various locations, including DeSales University in PA, Danbury Sportsdome in CT, and Superdome Sports in NJ. Specific locations are listed for each event.

6. What is the College Pathway Residential Camp?

The Residential Camp is a three-day, two-night event at DeSales University where college coaches observe and lead training sessions. Players will



participate in college-style training and internal matches, with footage captured for their highlight reels.

7. How do players get exposure to college coaches?

Players will showcase their skills at multiple showcases and combines, where college coaches from various programs, including Ivy League and Division I, II, and III schools, will be present. Players also receive personalized recruitment advice from NCE consultants.

8. What support is provided for the college recruitment process?

NCE offers personal college consultancy, helping players manage recruitment timelines, NCAA compliance, communication strategies, and creating recruitment materials like profile pages and highlight reels.

9. Are travel expenses included in the program fee?

No, travel expenses to and from events are the responsibility of the family.

10. Can I get a refund if my child can no longer participate?

NCE Soccer does not offer refunds for this program. However, credits may be considered in cases of long-term injury.

11. How do we register for the program?

You can register through the NCE Family portal. The registration process starts with a \$699 deposit.

12. What are the key expectations for players?

Players are expected to take ownership of their recruitment process, attend all NCE Soccer events, prepare thoroughly, and give maximum effort. This includes being punctual and completing assignments as part of the program.

13. What is included in the player profile page?

The player profile page includes personal and academic details, test scores, highlight videos, photos, and important documents like transcripts and achievements.
