PACKING LIST

- Camp Package - Red & Blue Nike Jersey with black Nike Shorts & Socks
- Players will receive a voucher which is included in the camp fee to purchase the required camp package from the soccer.com website.
- All soccer equipment include - cleats, turf shoes, indoor shoes, running shoes, GK gloves (For keepers) and slides.
- Water Bottle
- In addition to the full camp kit all NCE players will need their complete NCE black COE training kit and the white COE training shirt.
- Casual wear for downtime and evenings.

MEDICAL NEEDS

- There will be a trainer at camp for player's medical needs during sessions
- All players are required to provide a completed NCE medical authorization form to participate on camp.

FOOD AND DIETARY NEEDS

- ALL dietary needs are catered for by the hotel. For those campers with severe allergies, we will ask you to make the hotel aware of this before the event so they can plan.
- Non-perishable snacks & drinks can be kept in the family's hotel room.
- Families are not restricted to the hotel and can dine where they please. The resort does have

extensive dining options.

MISCELLANEOUS

- The hotel offers a laundry service otherwise training items can be washed in the tub.
- The hotel offers a shuttle service to theme parks

- The camp staff is made up of NCE Coaching Staff and International Academy Coaches from top clubs from around the World.
- Goalkeepers will have their own coach and work together then join in with the other players for the evening games.
- The expected coach to player ratio is approximately 1:15 for U9 to U12 and 1:18 for U13 to U18.
